The Ad hoc committee that visited your meeting of March 15, 2011 and discussing with you during and after your meeting the concerns you have about the future of the LSCI.

During our conversations, Mr. Sumner Keyes as Chair of the committee made you aware that we were there only as an interested party and making no promises on behalf of KCCOA.

The committee found during the question and answer period that was held after the meeting. Mr. Noel "Stretch" Derouin indicated that the LSCI would like the City of Lemoore to help with trash and utility cost.

The KCCOA has no involvement with that issue.

KCCOA asked John Gordon who is a member of the ad hoc committee and also on the City of Lemoore Council, if he would look in to that area for you.

The other main issue that was stressed by Mr. Derouin was about grant money that KCCOA could possibly get from the Federal Government and / or from the State of California for LSCI.

This an area that KCCOA does not do for agencies other than those that are directly connected with KCCOA.

Securing grant money is something that you can accomplish with the help of a lady that we met there by the name of (Kathy). She indicated that she was familiar with grant acquisitions.

The director of KCCOA has indicated that she may be able to secure meals at a reasonable amount from their supplier for you, but that you and she would have to discuss this issue.

The committee likes the direction the board of directors seem to be headed in their work on behalf of the LSCI, and looking into ways of increasing the income to the treasury.

The committee would like to suggest that the Treasurer set up a budget and be more active in the income and the dispensation of the money per your by-laws as you have amended them.
