**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

The Minutes from the December 8, 2010 meeting were approved.

**DISCUSSION:**

Bill Redmond informed the committee that he heard a new Athletic Director (AD) was appointed on base. He will contact MWR and see about getting the AD, or his representative, to attend our committee meetings.

Trimming of the Palm Trees has been started. Superintendent Martinez is able to trim the lower trees, and a person is being hired to trim the taller Palms.

A tour of the back nine holes was taken and these were the observations and comments:

It was recommended that signs be put up to direct golfers to holes 10, 12 and 15. Also that the rocks used at Tee Markers and the doors on the bathroom be repainted.

Use of crushed asphalt on the cart paths and ball washer areas has really cut down on the water accumulation.

The green on hole 11 has improved. The green pineapple grass is greatly diminished.

Holes 11, 12, 17 & 18 are great examples of trenching for drainage and to get water to dry spots.

The bunkers have new sand and are being kept well manicured. On hole 16 two small bunkers were made into one larger bunker, giving the hole a new look and making it easier to maintain and mow.

The yardage markers have been repainted, making it easier to spot them.

New trees have been planted on 15 and 17. On 17 the trees were added to narrow the fairway. Irrigation on the left has promoted good grass growth.

The fairway on 18 serves as an example of what the entire course could look like with additional time and money. The weeds were spot treated, and it has a solid base of Bermuda.

The extension of the putting green by the range is coming in nicely. Superintendent Martinez plans to overseed again in April/May.

The interior and exterior of the Clubhouse have seen many improvements. The addition of a new flat-screen TV, new paint on the exterior, shutters and new lights make a huge difference.
