
To Whom it May Concern:

I understand that the City is looking for short term representation on the Architectural Design Review Committee. Based on past City code, the Community Development Director or Planning Director has been required to serve on the Committee and did not previously have an expiration period. Almost two years ago the Council modified the text to not require the Planning Director to serve, however the Mayor could appoint whomever they wanted, and at that time left me to serve as a member on the Committee. Should the Council need to have representation on the Committee, I am willing to serve to avoid long delays to future submittals that may be received during the interim period before the new Zoning Code is in place (which is anticipated to change the design review structure).
