SUBJECT: Summary of Training

Commander:

Here is a summary of the training that I received at the CRPOA Conference in San Jose, August 25 – 27, 2011.

August 25:

Express Interrogation: This class covered procedures for interrogating suspects in the field where we might not have time for a more formal interrogation. The training focused on RET: establishing Rapport, working with the Emotion created and finally establishing the Truth.

Combat Grappling: This class was a hands on class in self defense in a hand to hand scenario.

August 26:

Gang Trends and Strategies: This class covered various topics related to gang activities. The penal code sections related to gangs were reviewed. There is a new gang trend developing known as Juggalos and Juggolets. These are primarily teenagers and the trend is based on music recorded by a group back east.

Reserve Coordinator Update: This was a discussion class where various topics regarding the operation of a Reserve Program were discussed. Topics included Reserve officer levels and assignments, recruitment and retention. I gave Officer Cardaras a folder from the class.

August 27:

Carrying Concealed Weapons: This class covered the moral and legal requirements for law enforcement officers carrying concealed weapons. Various Penal Code sections were reviewed as well as the penal code sections relating to weapons and the changes in those sections during the last legislative session. Discussion was also held regarding Title 18 Chap. 44 U.S.C. and LEOSA as both relate to Reserve officers.

Penal Code/Vehicle code Update: This class covered changes in both of these codes during the last legislative session.

Please note: CRPOA provided all participants a "thumb drive" with outlines and other information from all class offered.
