City of Lemoore:

We are working on the feasibility of filming an independent feature film in Lemoore. Lemoore has many features and amenities that would work well in the right movie. I have spent several years in Lemoore and have become very familiar with the uniqueness of the town, citizens, government and businesses. I have incorporated many of these unique features into the script.

Currently, I have a distributor who will distribute the movie to overseas markets and pitch it to the U.S. markets. I have a director from Los Angeles willing to direct the movie. Several of the main characters have agreed to act in the movie and I have plans to include two Hollywood actors (one male and one female) as day actors.

At this point I need to secure the locations for the movie. Once this is done I can begin the funding process, secure the Hollywood and local actors, lock the shooting dates and begin the production of the movie.

I want this to be a win win situation for everyone. We need to use many of the city's facilities and amenities to make this movie a success. For the use and involvement of these facilities and amenities we plan to market the production of the movie in hopes of bringing an influx of people, media and revenue to the City of Lemoore.

Furthermore, I will hold auditions for the remaining roles in Lemoore. Our intent is to have Lemoore High School drama and band students fill these roles. This kind of exposure can really make a student's career and build morale and excitement at the school, throughout the community and area.

In addition, I am working on providing funds from the movie premier for the Lemoore High School drama and band programs as well as the Lemoore Recreation Center Drama program. The net proceeds from the Local premier will be donated to these entities.

Our film schedule will coincide with the Lemoore High School Christmas holiday vacation schedule. We will also film on weekends in January and February. Specific dates for each scene will be locked once we have all our locations. For more information contact Scott Seargeant at (559) 799-8805.

LOCATIONS

The specific locations and amenities needed are:

1. **The City Council Chambers - 1 Scene**
Est. Time: 4 hours
This scene involves the City Council and the Police Dept. (including the Named Actor).
2. **Mooney Museum House & Mortuary - 4 Scenes**
Est. Time: 2.5 days
These scenes involve the beginning and the end of the movie.
3. **Police Department Personnel/Vehicle - Montage**
Est. Time: 4 hours for personnel, 2 hours for one vehicle. 1 hour at police station.
We would like to use two Lemoore police officers in the movie as support for the Named Actor but we can use all actors if the police are not available. We will need to film several montages involving police cars.
4. **Volunteer Fire Department – 4 Scenes**
Estimated time: 8 hours in four scenes; two during the day two at sunset.
Again we would like to use 3-5 real firemen in these scenes especially a driver and operators. We need a fire truck in these scenes. The firefighters save the day!
We understand that all City employees job comes first and we will be accommodating in all aspects of this should they be on set and need to attend to urgent job related matters.
5. **Downtown Merchants and Roads – Several Scenes**
Est. Time: up to 10 days including several early morning shoots. Most will be partial days. Our main use will be at the intersection of Fox & “D” Streets centered in and around the Christmas tree. Also, Fox Street and “D” Street.
6. **Train Station & Tracks/Railcar – 1 Scene**
Est. Time: 4hrs. at sunset
This scene involves the firefighters and the fire truck.
7. **Lemoore High School – Several Scenes**
Estimated Time: 7 days
There are multiple scenes at a high school both indoors and out. We need the use of the gym, nurse’s station, classroom, outdoor space, front of school, parking lot, and possibly a rooftop. We will need a bus for two scenes and roughly 100 students. Some of the students will have lines, some will be background and the rest will be zombies. We will use drama students and the marching band.
8. **Elementary School – 1 Scene**
Est. Time: 2 hours
This is out side in the drop off area. It’s a short scene. Will need roughly 20 kids and a few parents in this scene.
9. **Lemoore Cinemas – 1 Scene**
Est. Time: 6 hours.
We need a rooftop fight scene. Also we would like to hold the premier in Lemoore at the theater or other large venue establishment.

10. 2 Residential Houses – 3 Scenes

I need two houses next to each other. These residences should be in a quieter area and be the type a teacher could afford. *The Named Female Actor* will be in one of these scenes which will increase the value of the house. We could use two empty houses that are on the market to help them sell.
