Dear Mayor Siegel:

I would like to state emphatically that, as of the date of this letter, the Lemoore Senior Center will not be supplanting any local or state funding if we receive any funds from the CDBG grant process.

I have also included, as an attachment to this letter, the treasurer's report for the previous year. Although the report is accurate, I apologize for the untidiness of the document. It has been difficult to perform all the duties that have been place upon us without a fulltime staff. Running the management of the center with its various programs, and maintaining the facility itself are both full time jobs. As evidenced in the report we have no fulltime staff and cannot afford to pay at this time. This leaves the board and I stretched very thin.

As you can see, the report shows that the largest expense we incur is the senior lunch program. Sadly, while this program is invaluable to the local senior population, we have been forced by financial reasons to increase the price we charge for lunch. This has had a devastating effect on both membership and our seniors as individuals as well.

On behalf of the Lemoore Senior Center, I would like to thank the City of Lemoore for all it has done to date, including granting us the property on which we now sit. Further, we acknowledge and greatly appreciate the City's willingness apply for CDBG funding in 2014 in an effort to end the financial hardships we have been experiencing.

Dear Mayor Siegel:

After speaking to members of our Board of Directors about the 2014 application for a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), the Lemoore Senior Citizens, Inc. have decided we are supportive of all three phases the application: Rehabilitation of the buildings comprising the Lemoore Senior Center; re-implementing a five day per week lunch program where the cost to seniors is partially subsidized; and provision of paid staff for on-site management and maintenance. It is anticipated that the improvements as listed in the grant application would:


- Take care of health, safety and handicapped accessibility needs;
- Repair or replace deferred maintenance issues;
- Replace energy inefficient utilities; and






