Subject: Bid Award – 2014 Resurfacing Project

Discussion:

The project consists, in general, of resurfacing the project streets, replacing ADA ramps within the project area and restriping the street centerlines and bike paths to current State Standards:

Base Bid

Club Drive – Lemoore Avenue to Murphy Drive
Cinnamon Drive – Lemoore Avenue to Venice Avenue
G Street – Hill Street to Fox Street
Larish Street – Champion Street to Lemoore Avenue

Alternate Bid #1

Cinnamon Drive – Venice Avenue to Balboa Avenue

Alternate Bid #2

Fox Street – G Street to Cinnamon Drive

Alternate Bid #3

Intersection of Hamlet Street and Skaggs Street – Valley Gutter and ADA Ramps

Alternate Bid #4

Intersection of Hamlet Street and Toomey Street – Valley Gutter and ADA Ramps

The City of Lemoore received seven bids for the project on February 11, 2015, with the following results:

The project is to be awarded as stated in the Notice to Contractors on the base bid. The City may elect to award all, none or a combination of Alternate Bids.

Staff is recommending the base bid and all four alternates be awarded to Cen Cal Paving in the amount of \$679,032.70. The project is scheduled to begin in March and end in June 2015.

Budget Impact:

The 2014 Resurfacing Project will be funded in the amount of \$679,032.70 through the (065) Street Capital Fund account which has a projected balance of \$689,115.00 in the 2013-2015 Capital Improvement Budget.

Recommendation:

That the City Council, by motion, award the bid to Cen Cal Paving for the 2014 Resurfacing Project in the amount of \$679,032.70 and authorize the City Manager to sign the agreement and contracts.
