Subject: Bid Award – Construction of Street Improvements and Irrigation Pipeline Improvements at Cinnamon Municipal Complex

Discussion:

This project was designed by Blair, Church and Flynn and consists, in general, of undergrounding the Dockstetter Ditch, widen Cinnamon Drive from Hill Street to the Lemoore Sports Complex, and construction of sidewalk, curb and gutter, street lights and landscaping.

The City of Lemoore received two bids for the project on May 29, 2015, with the following results:

Yarbs Grading and Paving	\$895,345
Bill Nelson General Engineering Construction	\$939,877
Engineer's Estimate	\$868,000

Staff is recommending the bid be awarded to Yarbs Grading and Paving in the amount of \$895,345. The project is scheduled to begin in August with completion late September 2015. In addition to the construction costs, Staff would also like to request additional funding for the cost of compaction testing, construction overview and contingencies in the amount of \$450,000.

Budget Impact:

Total budget amount for the Cinnamon Drive Project will be \$1,345,345. The 2013-15 Street Capital Fund (028-033) appropriated amount was \$650,000 which included \$419,000 from State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) funds and \$231,000 Local Transportation Funds. Budget amendment amount of \$695,000 will be funded through the 065 Street Capital Fund.

Recommendation:

That the City Council, by motion, approve the budget amendment in the amount of \$695,000 and award the bid to Yarbs Grading and Paving for the Construction of Street Improvements and Irrigation Pipeline Improvements at Cinnamon Municipal Complex in the amount of \$895,345 and authorize the City Manager to sign the agreement and contracts.
