PRESS RELEASE

On Wednesday, 04/27/16 at about 0117 hours, the Lemoore Police Department was dispatched to Micky's Bar & Grill, located at 230 Fox St., regarding a male victim who had been stabbed. Upon arrival, LPD officers located the victim sitting outside of the bar. During the investigation it was determined that the victim was in the area of Heinlen St. and G St., when he was approached by two males. The victim reported he was involved in a physical fight with the two males. During the fight, the victim reported he was stabbed twice, once in the neck and once in the back. The victim stated he ran and made his way to Micky's Bar & Grill where he asked several patrons for help. The victim was subsequently transported to the Community Regional Medical Center in Fresno by an ambulance.

Detectives suspect the stabbing to be gang-related. The Kings County Gang Task Force has been called to help in the investigation. One suspect is described as a Hispanic male adult, last seen wearing a Dallas Cowboys hat, having long hair, wearing a blue shirt and blue jeans.
