PRESS RELEASE

On Wednesday, August 20, 2014 at approximately 3:40 p.m. Lemoore police officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Devon Drive for a stabbing that had just occurred. When officers arrived they found a 17 year old male who had been stabbed in the abdomen. The victim was not cooperative, but officers were able to determine that there were 2-4 suspects in a vehicle who confronted the victim. One of the suspects stabbed the victim and then they all fled in the same vehicle. The victim was transported to the hospital by ambulance. His wound did not appear to be life threatening.

Gang Task Force investigators were on duty and responded to assist with the investigation. They worked throughout the night and were able to identify and arrest the suspects, 19 year old Antonio Torres of Lemoore, and three 15 year old males. The suspects were booked in the Kings County Jail and juvenile hall, respectively, for attempted murder, conspiracy, destroying evidence, and a gang enhancement.
