**MINUTES**

## **CALL TO ORDER:**

Commissioner McGhuey called the Session to order at 7:08 pm.

## **COMMISSION MEMBERS PRESENT:**

Commissioners: Fuller, McGhuey, Smith, Wilderson, Sandoval and Director Simonson.

## **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

It was moved by Commissioner Wilderson and Seconded by Commissioner Sandoval to approve the minutes from July 10, 2012 and July 16, 2012.

## **PUBLIC COMMENTS:**

Billy Siegel addressed the commission concerning the Kings Swim Club and the Lemoore High School Pool. Mr. Siegel stated that the Swim Club was bumped out of their time slot at the pool by the High School Water Polo team. Mr. Siegel stated that the pool was paid for with tax payer money and should be available for use by the citizens of Lemoore. Mr. Siegel was asked if they had a signed agreement and he stated he would confirm and request a copy. Director Simonson ensured Mr. Siegel he would contact Debbie Muro at Lemoore High School and discuss the situation with her. He felt it could be worked out between the two of them.

## **DISCUSSION:**

Scott Seargeant gave the commissioners an update on filming a movie in Lemoore that would be sold in the United States and Overseas. The Recreation Drama students and the Lemoore High School Drama students would be extras in the movie. All Commissioners were in favor.

An update was given to the commissioners on Evening Under the Stars. Ticket sales are going well.

The commissioners were given information on the Heritage Park Beautification Project that would take place on October 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup>. The Recreation Department is seeking 200 volunteers to plant 450 trees in order to prepare the park for disk golf. This project is part of the Cal Fire Green Trees for the Golden State grant that the city received.

## **UPDATES:**

The Commissioners were informed that the Lemoore Sports Foundation received a one time \$7,000.00 payment.

Sheila Taylor updated the commissioners on open play and the fees.

Eric Ferreira informed the commission that the adult volunteer base was growing and that there would be 10 adult volunteers at the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade dance on Friday, August 17<sup>th</sup>.
