Subject: Development of Kings County Corporate Games

Proposed Motion:

To develop Corporate Games in order to promote physical fitness, team work and healthy lifestyles for the residents of Kings County and to generate new income for our department.

Subject/Discussion:

For the past two years, the idea of hosting Corporate Games has come up while working on the next year's Recreation Guide. Corporations, Businesses, Service Organization, School Employees would develop teams for a week of activities. There would be a different activity every day. Activities could include: indoor soccer, kickball, softball, Texas Hold'em, three point shot contest, Footgolf, 5K run and many more. There would be a certain amount of players for each event. The same players could participate in all events in order for a small business to enter or two small businesses could join forces in order to have more participants. Medals would be given out for each event and an overall winner would receive a trophy at the end.

Financial Consideration(s):

We are discussing charging \$350 per team. We would like to have 15 to 20 teams participate which would generate income from \$5,250.00 to \$7,000.00. Depending on what events are scheduled, there would be expenses such as referees for indoor soccer, poker chips for Texas Hold'em, balls for kickball, medals and so on. I have attached a one week initial plan of events to give you an idea of costs.

Alternatives or Pros/Cons:

Pros:

- Promotes healthy lifestyles
- Promotes team work
- Generates revenue for the department
- Introduces new people to Footgolf
- Brings new people to the Recreation Center, Kings Lions Complex and the Golf Course.

Cons:

- Recreation Staff would have to flex their hours during Corporate Game week.
- An extensive amount of planning
- Volunteers would have to be recruited

That the Parks and Recreation Commission approve the development of Corporate Games in order to generate new revenue and promote team work and healthy lifestyles in our community.
