Dear City of Lemoore Customers:

The City of Lemoore has adopted an urgency ordinance amending changes to the Lemoore Water Conservation Plan. **We will be enforcing these regulations.** You can also refer to www.lemoore.com
The City of Lemoore water conservation ordinance contains the following requirements:

1. NO outdoor watering on Monday, Thursday and Friday.
2. EVEN NUMBER ADDRESSES may water on TUESDAY and SATURDAY.
3. ODD NUMBER ADDRESSES may water on WEDNESDAY and SUNDAY.
4. Residents with drip irrigations systems will no longer be exempt from watering day restrictions.
5. No watering between 10:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on your watering day.
6. Summer water toys may be used in place of sprinklers or hoses on scheduled watering days.
7. Washing of cars, boats or other vehicles for residential purposes may be done on any day. Buckets and shut-off nozzles on hoses must be used when washing these vehicles in order to reduce water runoff. **Car washes for fundraising events are prohibited.**
8. A permit to drain a swimming pool must be obtained from the Lemoore Public Works Department before any work is done. There is no cost to obtain this permit.
9. The Water Ordinance applies to City supplied water. Residents who are using their own wells for irrigation purposes are asked to contact Lemoore Public Works with that information and to also conserve well water.
10. Hotels, restaurants and bars shall only provide drinking water to customers upon request.
11. No person shall allow excessive water to run from their property onto streets or highways. Washing of exterior asphalt or concrete areas is prohibited except as provided for in Health Department or Fire Department regulations.
12. Penalties have increased for second and subsequent violations as follows: Second violation - \$25; Third violation - \$50; Fourth violation - \$100; Fifth violation – A written notice will be given of a fifth violation and the consumer shall have a flow restrictor placed in their service until such time that they can assure the public works director that no more waste will occur. All costs, including overhead, for this installation shall be billed to the customer.
