**A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LEMOORE
DETERMINING THAT THE CITY'S 2011-02013 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM
BUDGET IS GENERALLY IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE LEMOORE GENERAL PLAN AS
PER GOVERNMENT CODE 65401 WITH EXCEPTIONS DISCUSSED BELOW**

At the Regular Meeting of the Planning Commission of the City of Lemoore duly called and held on January 9, 2012, at 7:00 p.m. on said day, it was moved by Commissioner _____, seconded by Commissioner _____ and carried that the following Resolution be adopted:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 65401, the Planning Commission must make a determination that improvement program budgets are in conformance with the Lemoore General Plan; and

WHEREAS, Bi-annually the City Council adopts a Capital Improvement Program Budget; and

WHEREAS, City staff reviewed and Planning Commission concurs that all pertinent General Plan policies to insure that the aforementioned budgets were in conformance with the Lemoore General Plan as stated in the Government Code Section 65401 and determined that The Fiscal Year 2011-2013 Capital Improvement Program Budget is generally in conformance with the existing Lemoore General Plan so long as the policies listed in the report are incorporated as projects move forward.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Planning Commission of the City of Lemoore does determine that the 2011-2013 Capital Improvement Program budget is generally in conformance with the 2030 Lemoore General Plan.
