Discussion:

ABx1 26 was signed by the Governor on June 28, 2011. This legislation provides for the dissolution of redevelopment agencies and provides for an administrative process to wind down agency activities and dispose of agency assets. The legislation creates two new public entities: successor agencies and oversight boards.

Successor agencies are designated as the successor entities to the former redevelopment agencies (§§ 34171 (j), 34173(a).) All authority, rights, duties and obligations previously vested with the former redevelopment agency are now vested in the successor agency. The City of Lemoore, through Resolution 2012-03 confirmed the City's intention to serve as the Successor Agency to the Lemoore Redevelopment Agency.

Each successor agency has an oversight board composed of seven members (§§ 34171(f), 34179(a).) The oversight board directs staff of the successor agency to perform work in furtherance of the oversight's board's duties and responsibilities.

It appears from the legislation that the oversight board is a local entity for purposes of the Political Reform Act, as well as the Public Records Act and the Brown Act.
