## PRESS RELEASE

During the early morning hours of September 10, 2017, Lemoore Police Department Officers located several businesses that had been vandalized by graffiti. The businesses were located in the downtown business district of Lemoore and were within a 3 block area. The vandalisms consisted of graffiti on the outside of the locations and collectively the estimated damage exceeded \$400.00, making the crimes a felony.

On September 10, 2017, at approximately 1900 hours, The Lemoore Police Department received a call from a citizen of Lemoore reporting two subjects walking near the railroad tracks in the downtown area of Lemoore. The citizen reported that the subjects were vandalizing the railroad cars on the tracks. When officers arrived on scene they located both subjects and found graffiti on the railroad cars. A further investigation revealed that one of the two subjects located near the train tracks was involved in the vandalism of the businesses earlier that morning as well as the vandalism to the train car.

Casey Taylor, 32 years of age, from Lemoore was arrested for felony vandalism and booked into the Kings County Jail. Taylor's bail was set at \$30,000.
