PRESS RELEASE

On August 13, 2014 at about 4:50 a.m., Lemoore police officers were dispatched to a commercial burglary at Gunny's Sandwich Shop in the 500 block of N. Lemoore Ave. The owner arrived at work and found that the business had been broken into and the registers, as well as an undetermined amount of money, were missing. After viewing the surveillance video, the owner believed that the suspect may be a former employee. At about 8:30 a.m. Lemoore police officers and Kings County Probation officers conducted a probation search at the former employee's home in the 100 block of Oleander Ave. in Lemoore. During the probation search, officers located much of the stolen items, including cash drawers, deposit bags, and cash, as well as drug paraphernalia. The suspect and former employee, 32 year old Margaret Lynn, was interviewed and eventually confessed to the burglary. She was arrested for burglary, possession of stolen property, possession of drug paraphernalia and child endangerment. She was booked into the Kings County Jail and her bail was set at \$85,000.00.
