On 05/21/17 at approximately 0205 hours, Lemoore Police Officers were on a call for service when they observed a disturbance occurring in the 100 block of Skaggs Street. The officer on scene heard a subject state "you wanna get stabbed" and then saw several subjects get into a physical altercation in front of a residence. Officers immediately responded to the scene at which time the offenders fled. Due to the close proximity of assisting officers, a perimeter was established around the area and the suspects were contained within it.

Officers contacted a subject, a 26 year old northern gang member, and rendered aid for injuries to his face and torso. During this time it was discovered that he had received several lacerations and two puncture wounds to his body. He was transported to Kaweah Delta Hospital where he was treated for his injuries.

Lemoore Police Detectives and Investigators from the Kings County Gang Task Force arrived on scene and continued investigating the incident. Based on information obtain on the scene a search warrant was served on a residence in the 100 block of Skaggs street and four suspects were taken into custody in relation to this incident. All four are believed to be Bulldog gang members out of Coalinga.

The three adult suspects Shaun Rector 01/02/1999, Daniel Sanchez 04/14/1985, and Tres Tadlock 03/10/1996 were booked into the Kings County Jail for attempted murder, assault with a deadly weapon causing great bodily injury, and a gang enhancement. Their bail was set at \$575,000. The 17 year old male was booked into the Kings County Juvenile Center and will be held without bail.
