PRESS RELEASE

On October 22, 2016, at about 12:04 am, a Lemoore police officer was patrolling in the area of Fox St. and C St. when he observed a vehicle approaching with its high beams on. The officer turned around and initiated a traffic stop in the 500 block of B St. Upon contacting the driver, later identified as 18 year old Jacob Maciel of Lemoore, the officer noticed the smell of marijuana coming from within the vehicle. Maciel told the officer he had marijuana in his pocket and that he did not have a marijuana recommendation card.

The officer asked Maciel to step out of the vehicle for further investigation, and when Maciel exited the vehicle the officer observed a 9mm handgun on the floor board under the driver's seat. When the officer checked the gun he found it was loaded. Officers located marijuana and cash in Maciel's pocket. Maciel was arrested and booked into the Kings County Jail for possession of a concealed firearm, possession of a loaded firearm in a public place, possession of marijuana for sale, transportation of marijuana for sale, and driving without a license. His bail was set at \$85,000.
