PRESS RELEASE

On September 19th, 2016 at about 2:30 pm, Lemoore police officers responded to an address in the City of Lemoore in response to a check the welfare. The reporting party told officers they had not heard from her adult daughter in two weeks and believed she was being physically abused by her boyfriend, 19 year old Savion Lewis. A check on Savion Lewis showed he had a warrant for his arrest for vehicle theft in Alameda County.

Officers were able to make contact with the female inside the residence, who reported that she was being physically abused by Lewis. It was also discovered that Savion was hiding from officers inside the attic of the residence and may be in possession of a semi-automatic handgun.

The residence, along with a neighboring residence, was evacuated due to safety concerns. Officers talked with Lewis for about 2 hours but he refused to come down from the attic. The Lemoore Police Department's K-9 officer responded, and Lewis then started talking to the officers. Officers were able to get a ladder and Lewis eventually came down from the attic and was taken into custody. He was booked at the Kings County Jail for felony domestic violence and the Alameda County warrant. His bail was set at \$70,000.
