PRESS RELEASE

On November 4, 2014 at approximately 6:30 p.m., Lemoore police officers were dispatched to a residence in the 600 block of Huntington Ct. regarding a subject who had reportedly been shot. When officers arrived they located one victim with a single gunshot wound to his abdomen. The victim was transported by helicopter to the Community Regional Medical Center in Fresno for treatment.

During the course of the initial investigation, officers learned that the shooting occurred at an apartment complex in the 1100 block of W. Bush Street. The victim told officers that he had taken a taxi to the apartment complex, where he was confronted by several suspects, one of whom shot him. The victim then got back in the taxi and told the driver to take him to the hospital. The driver was unable to take him to the hospital so he drove the victim to his [the victim's] home in Lemoore. Two firearms were recovered in the taxi, one of which had previously been reported stolen out of Fresno.

The victim underwent surgery for his injury but is expected to survive. At this time few other details are known regarding this case. No suspects or other victims have been identified. This case is still currently under investigation and anyone with information about this crime is urged to call the Lemoore Police Department at (559) 924-9574.
