On May 20, 2016 at about 8:15 am Lemoore police officers were dispatched to the 300 block of West D Street for a report of a suspicious object. When officers arrived they contacted the caller, who said that he went out to his vehicle, which was parked in the 300 block of West D Street, and saw the item on the front of the vehicle. The item was cylindrical in shape and about 8 inches tall. It had two wires coming out of the top. Wording on the item read that it was a military adapter-booster bomb nose. Lemoore officers closed the block to vehicle and pedestrian traffic.

The Tulare County Consolidated Explosive Ordinance Disposal unit responded and removed the object and conducted a further examination of it. On May 23, 2016 the Lemoore Police Department was told by a T.C.C.E.O.D. supervisor that the object contained no incendiary materials.
