On October 13, 2016 at about 8:45 am Lemoore police officers were dispatched to the 900 block of Paradise Dr. in Lemoore in regards to a burglary in progress. A resident had returned home to find a subject inside her home. The suspect ran from the residence as the victim called the police. Lemoore police officers, along with Kings County Sheriff's deputies, set up a perimeter in the area. A Lemoore Police Department detective saw a subject in the 18000 block of Indiana Avenue who matched the description given by the victim. The detective attempted to detain the subject, but the subject ran through a residential neighborhood. A Kings County deputy was able to take the suspect, Tyrei Miles, into custody a short time later. A witness reported seeing Miles near a vacant house in the 13000 block of 18th Avenue. Lemoore officers and Kings County Sheriff's deputies checked the vacant house and found some of the property stolen during the burglary in the back yard. A second vacant house in the area was searched and additional stolen property was located in the back yard of that residence. The property that was stolen and recovered included several firearms, electronics, and other household items. The investigation is ongoing, including whether Miles was involved in any other recent burglaries.

Miles was booked into the Kings County Jail for burglary, committing a crime for the benefit of a criminal street gang, and resisting arrest. His bail was set at \$105,000.
