1. Call to Order and Roll Call

2. PUBLIC COMMENT:

3. APPROVAL – Minutes – Regular Meeting – June 12, 2018:

4. INFORMATION ONLY – Parks and Recreation Commissioners' Adoption and/or Monitoring of Lemoore City Parks:

Parks and Recreation Director Glick stated this item was requested by Commissioners at the last meeting. The areas included are City Park, Heritage Park, Lions Park, Kings Lions Complex, Lemoore Youth Sports Park and the CMC. A Lemoore Park and Facility checklist was provided to use at the parks.

Commissioners will stop by the Parks and Recreation Department for a listing of upcoming events on a regular basis.

5. INFORMATION ONLY – Lemoore Youth Sports Park Grand Opening:

Parks and Recreation Director Glick stated the ceremonial grand opening was July 14, 2018. The City officially took over on July 2, 2018. Five year agreements have been entered into with Lemoore Youth Soccer and Lemoore Youth Softball. The complex is open to the public, however, it is still primarily for youth sports. The City maintenance crew is doing an excellent job. The complex is available for special events. Parks and Recreation is searching grants for funding.

6. INFORMATION ONLY – Senior Meal Program:
Parks and Recreation Director Glick stated Council asked Parks and Recreation if they could assist the Senior Center with the KCAG food program. KCAG is going through budget issues and the senior meal program was not approved. Parks and Recreation solicited donations and were able to provide meals for the month of July.

Parks and Recreation Director Glick stated the Lemoore Youth Committee last met in May. They have bimonthly meetings. The next meeting is September 20, 2018 at 5:30pm. The Lemoore Youth Committee would like to create its own event or shadow a Parks and Recreation event.
8. INFORMATION ONLY – Lemoore Senior Advisory Committee:
Parks and Recreation Director Glick stated the Lemoore Senior Advisory Committee meets bimonthly. The big item on their agenda is the meal program. Talk about general items and meetings have been informative.

Commissioner Rossi thanked everyone for their hard work. Attended the Volunteer Appreciation Ceremony as Lions Club sponsors. It was well attended. Hats off to staff for accepting special needs volunteers.

Commissioner Smith concurred with Commissioner Chaney. Commend staff for their hard work. Impressed with the Volunteer group. CMC complex is going great.

Commissioner Fuller stated there was an incident at the CMC approximately two weeks ago. An older female set her glasses and water bottle down and someone took her items. No staff available at the early hours. Individuals needs to be aware to not leave items unattended. Commissioner Rossi suggested in the future rental lockers for personal effects. Potentially put cameras in the CMC in the future.

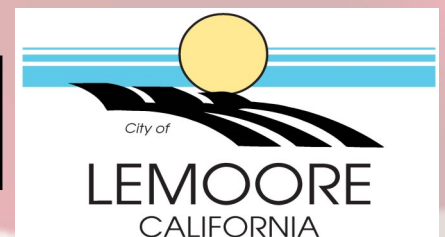
