PRESS RELEASE

On 08/07/18 at 12:50pm, the Problem Oriented Policing (POP) Team, with the help of the Lemoore Police Department Detectives Unit, and in conjunction with the Kings County Probation Department, executed a probation search at a residence in the 100 block of Follett Street. This search was due in large part from complaints received by citizens in the area reporting heavy foot traffic and suspicious activity throughout the day and night.

When LPD officers entered inside the residence they encountered multiple subjects throughout the home and in the back yard. Each subject was detained and searched pursuant to the probation status of the individuals and home. As the search was being conducted, a loaded firearm was found in one of the rooms. Upon realizing the gun was found, one subject, Roman Alonzo (21 years old) of Lemoore, ran from the home and was caught at B Street and N. Lemoore Ave after a foot pursuit. He was arrested and charged with felon in possession of a firearm, felon in possession of ammunition, and resisting/delaying a police officer. His bail was set at \$35,000.00

The following subjects were also arrested at the residence:

-Jason Jones (29 years old) of Lemoore was arrested for possession of a controlled substance, possession of drug paraphernalia, and being under the influence of a controlled substance. His bail was set at \$15,000.00

-Jenny Solorio (22 years old) of Lemoore was arrested for possession of drug paraphernalia, and being under the influence of a controlled substance. Her bail was set at \$10,000.00.

-Heriberto Lopez (42 years old) of Lemoore was arrested for being under the influence of a controlled substance. His bail was set at \$5,000.00.

-Amelia Romero (61 years old) of Lemoore was arrested due to an outstanding \$20,000 dollar warrant for her arrest.

-Anna Corona (40 years old) of Lemoore was arrested due to a No Bail warrant for her arrest.

-Ruben Alonzo (51 years old) of Lemoore was cited for being in possession of a controlled substance and possession of drug paraphernalia.
