## PRESS RELEASE

On 08/01/2018 it was reported to the Lemoore Police Department an unknown suspect(s) had stolen multiple packages from the 1200 block of Paradise Loop. The suspect(s) had stolen multiple packages off the front porches of homes in the area. The victims in the case were able to provide video of the suspect stealing the items. The neighborhood itself is covered with high definition video cameras which showed the suspect vehicle, a black Hyundai with silver rims, in this area at the time of the theft.

Detectives began following leads on this case and on 08/09/2018 were able to identify the suspect as Karl Julius Jensen, 39 years old, out of Hanford. Lemoore Detectives, with the assistance of Kings County Probation, went to his residence in the 1200 block of Edgewood in Hanford and conducted a probation search. Located within the residence were several stolen items taken in one of the thefts.

Located in the driveway was the suspect vehicle. A search of that vehicle led to the discovery of additional items which had been stolen from a vehicle in Hanford on the morning of 08/09/2018. All of the recovered stolen property was seized and later returned to the owners.

Jensen was taken into custody for Grand Theft as well as for possession of stolen property and being under the influence of a controlled substance. Also located at the house was Victoria Diaz, 38 years old, out of Hanford. Diaz was found to be wanted by the California Department of Corrections and Rehabiliation for a parole violation. Both subjects were booked into the Kings County Jail and are being held without bail.
