The Committee provides recommendations to the City Council regarding expenditures of the Parking & Business Improvement Area (PBIA) Fund. Such expenditures may include Downtown music, street light banners, decorative refuse cans, benches, curbside planter boxes, promotional materials, holding promotional events such as the Kings County Homecoming (Lemoore Night), Holiday Stroll, street parties, Farmers markets, and other events as determined by the Committee to benefit the Downtown area.

Meetings are open to the public and everyone is encouraged to attend. Meeting dates/times are subject to change due to Holidays and scheduling conflicts.
