This Project is subject to prequalification. Design-build entities must submit completed prequalification applications to the City no later than January 31, 2019, at 5:00 p.m. A proposal submitted by a design-build entity that is not prequalified by Owner will not be accepted and will not be considered by Owner.

The Owner will not consider or accept any proposals from design-build entities who are not licensed to do business in the State of California, in accordance with the California Public Contract Code, providing for the licensing of design-build entities. Design-build entities shall maintain their licenses in good standing through Project completion and all applicable warranty periods.

Public works projects shall be subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations. A design-build entity or subcontractor shall not be qualified to submit a proposal or to be listed in a proposal subject to the requirements of Public Contract Code section 4104 unless currently registered and qualified under Labor Code section 1725.5 to perform public work as defined by Division 2, Part 7, Chapter 1 (§§1720 et seq.) of the Labor Code. A design-build entity or subcontractor shall not be qualified to enter into, or engage in the performance of, any contract of public work (as defined by Division 2, Part 7, Chapter 1 (§§1720 et seq.) of the Labor Code) unless currently registered and qualified under Labor Code section 1725.5 to perform public work.

The Director of Industrial Relations of the State of California, in the manner provided by law, has ascertained the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and rate for legal holidays and overtime work. The Contractor must pay for any labor therein described or classified in an amount not less than the rates specified. Copies of the required rates are on file at the Owner's Public Works Department and are available to any interested party on request.
