### 1. Call to Order and Roll Call At 5:33 p.m. the meeting was called to order.

- 4. INFORMATION ONLY Lemoore Youth Sports Park Update: Parks and Recreation Director Glick stated the City officially took over on July 2, 2018. A soccer event was held on Labor Day weekend and Lemoore Youth Soccer League has been playing every Saturday with practices during the week. Rental requests have been received including a middle school league. There will be two high school tourneys in December. Rough estimates for lighting for the four softball fields has been received. Seeking funding sources for the lighting.




