COVID-19 UPDATE

The City of Lemoore has received numerous calls from businesses in regards to COVID-19. On March 19, 2020, Governor Newsom issued Executive Order N-33-20, which places the state on a stay-at-home order. The federal government has identified 16 critical infrastructure sectors. The City is mandating that business owners assess the chart below to determine if the business is considered essential/non-essential. All non-essential businesses should **close** immediately. The City is very mindful of the current situation and how this is affecting the business environment. Although Lemoore officers will not be stopping folks in the midst of the shelter-in-place guidance issued Wednesday, the City Manager notes that business owners violating the mandatory closure notice may be fined or have their permits pulled.
