#### **Proposed Motion:**

Approve Resolution 2020-30 declaring properties a nuisance and setting a public hearing for October 20, 2020.

#### Subject/Discussion:

In the beginning of July, the City contacted the owners of 341 Heinlen/311 E Street due to the dangerous condition of their building. The South side of the building facing the alley is leaning, becoming structurally unsound. As a consequence of the condition, PG&E has disconnected the electricity to the entire building. Due to unsafe nature of the building, the City has restricted access, causing issues with collection of refuse for the surrounding businesses, and also inconveniencing several tenants which use the alley way to access their buildings. Since then, little has been done by the property owners to fix the building.

City of Lemoore Municipal Code Title 8 Chapter 2 titled "Dangerous Buildings," the first step towards the City remedying the issue is declaring the property a public nuisance via resolution. A notice will be posted and delivered to the property owners, allowing 30 days' notice for a public hearing. After the public hearing, City Council has the option to either allow the building owner time to complete repairs, or direct the Public Works Director to remove the building after another 30-day notice. If the City is forced to remove the building, the costs associated, will be assessed as a lien against the property with City Council's permission.

#### **Financial Consideration(s):**

If the City is forced to remove the building, the general fund will need to front the costs, until they can be recouped through a lien.

#### **Alternatives or Pros/Cons:**

#### Pros:

• The City moves toward making the property safe, and improving the current situation affecting the surrounding business' and apartment tenants.

#### Cons:

• The City could be out the cost of removal until the money is recouped.

#### **Commission/Board Recommendation:**

# A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEMOORE DECLARING A PUBLIC NUISANCE AT 341 HEINLEN/311 E STREET IN LEMOORE, AND SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING THEREON

WHEREAS, Lemoore Municipal Code Chapter 2 Title 8 Chapter 2 of the California Health and Safety Code Section 17920.3 provides a means for the City Council to find and declare public nuisances; and

**WHEREAS**, Lemoore Municipal Code Section 8-2-1 defines safety violations, subject to abatement proceedings, as ""[a]ll buildings or structures which are structurally unsafe, or are partially destroyed by fire, or dilapidated from old age, neglect, decay or other causes within the City which constitute a fire menace or are dangerous to human life, or a likely resort for vagrant or dissolute."

**WHEREAS,** the City Council has received a report that certain buildings and structures located in the City of Lemoore at 341 Heinlen/311 E Street constitute a public nuisance as these buildings and structures meet the definition of a safety violation under Lemoore Municipal Code Section 8-2-1; and

**WHEREAS,** the City Council desires to initiate that process which will abate and remove fire and public safety hazards from the City by declaring them to be public nuisances pursuant to the Municipal Code; and

**WHEREAS,** the City Council desires to set a public hearing as stated in the Municipal Code for the Council to hear and consider all objections and protest, if any; and

WHEREAS, at the conclusion of the public hearing the City Council may find and determine that such unsafe or dilapidated building or structure may be made safe by repair or that the Public Works Director may remove that said unsafe or dilapidated building or structure

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the City Council of the City of Lemoore, the following:

- 1. The Council hereby find and declares that 341 Heinlen/311 E Street is declared a public nuisance, unless deemed otherwise after the public hearing.
- 2. Said property is described as assessor parcel number 020-054-007-000 in the City of Lemoore, County of Kings.
- 3. The public hearing shall be held at the regular Council Meeting on October 20, 2020 at 7:30 pm or shortly thereafter where any objections will be heard
- 4. The City staff is directed to post notices of the public hearing and the resolution and to otherwise follow the processes described in Chapter 2 of Title 8 for the public hearing

hereby established.

5. The Public Works Director, or designee, is hereby directed to obtain bids and proceed with the removal of the public nuisance at the conclusion of the public hearing, unless otherwise dismissed.

# A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEMOORE AMENDING ITS CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE REGARDING DESIGNATED EMPLOYEES

**WHEREAS**, California Code of Regulations, Sections 18730 et seq., contain the terms of a standard conflict of interest code adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC); and

**WHEREAS**, the FPPC amends the conflict of interest code terms on a regular basis in accordance with the Political Reform Act found at Government Code Sections 81000 et seq.; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 17, 2018, the City Council of the City of Lemoore adopted Resolution No. 2018-37 that incorporated, by reference, the terms of California Code of Regulations, Sections 18730 et seq., along with the designation of employees and the formulation of disclosure categories; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Lemoore has recently reviewed its positions, and the duties of each position, and has determined that changes to the current conflict of interest code are necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, Government Code Section 87306 requires that a report be submitted to the City Council of the City of Lemoore identifying any changes in the conflict of interest code including, but not limited to, changes to designated employees.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Lemoore as follows:

- 1. The conflict of interest code for the City of Lemoore is hereby amended regarding designated employees as set forth in Exhibit "A."
- 2. All previously adopted designated employees regarding the conflict of interest code for the City of Lemoore are hereby rescinded.
- 3. All persons holding designated positions and those designated positions listed in Government Code Section 87200 shall file statements of economic interests as required by law.
  - 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

\*Consultants shall be included in the list of designated employees and shall disclose pursuant to the broadest disclosure category in the code subject to the following limitations:

The City Clerk of the City of Lemoore or his/her designee may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a "designated position, is hired to perform a range of duties that are limited in scope and thus is not required to fully comply with the disclosure requirements described in this section. Such written determination shall include a description of the consultant's duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The City Clerk's or his/her designee's determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as the Conflict of Interest Code.

# **2020 Conflict of Interest Code Biennial Notice Instructions for Local Agencies**

The Political Reform Act requires every local government agency to review its conflict of interest code biennially. A conflict of interest code tells public officials, governmental employees, and consultants what financial interests they must disclose on their Statement of Economic Interests (Form 700).

By **July 1, 2020:** The code reviewing body must notify agencies and special districts within its jurisdiction to review their conflict of interest codes.

By October 1, 2020: The biennial notice must be filed with the agency's code reviewing body.

The FPPC has prepared a 2020 Local Agency Biennial Notice form for local agencies to complete or send to agencies within its jurisdiction to complete before submitting to the code reviewing body. The City Council is the code reviewing body for city agencies. The County Board of Supervisors is the code reviewing body for county agencies and any other local government agency whose jurisdiction is determined to be solely within the county (e.g., school districts, including certain charter schools). #### Subject/Discussion:

June 18, 2019, Ordinance 2019-03 was approved to allow commercial cannabis operations in the City of Lemoore for the primary purpose of raising general fund revenue.

The Municipal Code Section 4-8-4(C)(12) currently reads that a Commercial Cannabis Operation "shall not be located within 600 feet from any existing school, daycare center or youth center defined by state law". In working with Commercial Cannabis operators, City staff has found the 600 foot radius limitation to be cumbersome and an impediment to the goal of raising general fund revenue for the City.

The amended Ordinance will allow that a Commercial Cannabis Operation to be located within 600 feet from any existing school, daycare center or youth center as defined by state law, or any other distance as approved by the Chief of Police.

The introduction and first reading of the ordinance occurred on August 18, 2020.

The amendment will further the goal raising general fund revenue.

# AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEMOORE AMENDING SECTION 4-8-4(C)(12) OF THE LEMOORE MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO THE DISTANCE WITHIN A SCHOOL, DAY CARE CENTER, OR YOUTH CENTER THAT A LICENSED COMMERCIAL CANNABIS OPERATION MAY NOT BE LOCATED

- **WHEREAS**, in November 2016, California citizens approved Proposition 64, known as "The Control, Regulate and Tax Adult Use of Marijuana Act," allowing for adult recreational use of cannabis in addition to compassionate medical use; and
- **WHEREAS,** on June 18, 2019, Ordinance 2019-03, to allow commercial cannabis operations in the City of Lemoore for the primary purpose of raising general fund revenue, was introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council; and
- **WHEREAS**, on July 2, 2019, Ordinance 2019-03 was passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the City Council; and
- **WHEREAS**, Municipal Code section 4-8-4(C), enacted as part of Ordinance 2019-03, establishes the minimum operational requirements and restrictions for a Commercial Cannabis Operation within the City; and
- **WHEREAS**, Municipal Code section 4-8-4(C)(1) requires a Commercial Cannabis Operation to comply with all State laws and obtain all required State licenses prior to opening for business; and
- **WHEREAS**, under California Business and Professions Code section 26054(b), "[a] premises licensed under this division shall not be located within a 600-foot radius of a school providing instruction in kindergarten or any grades 1 through 12, day care center, or youth center that is in existence at the time the license is issued, unless a licensing authority or a local jurisdiction specifies a different radius."
- **WHEREAS**, under Municipal Code section 4-8-4(C)(12), a Commercial Cannabis Operation "shall not be located within 600 feet from any existing school, daycare center or youth center as defined by state law;" and
- **WHEREAS**, under Municipal Code section 4-8-4(C)(12), a "school" is defined as "any public or private school providing instruction in kindergarten or grades 1-12, inclusive, but does not include any private school in which education is primarily conducted in private homes;" and
- **WHEREAS**, City staff, in working with potential Commercial Cannabis operators, has found the above-referenced 600 foot radius limitation to be cumbersome and an impediment to the goal of raising general fund revenue for the City; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City Council now desires to amend Municipal Code section 4-8-4(C)(12), so as to allow a Commercial Cannabis Operations to be located within 100 feet of a school, day care center, or youth center, so as to further the goal raising general fund revenue.

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# NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEMOORE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** Title 4, Chapter 8, Section 4-8-4, subdivision (C)(12) of the Lemoore Municipal Code is hereby amended in its entirety as follows:

- 12. Distance Separation from Schools, Daycare Centers and Youth Centers. A Commercial Cannabis Operation shall not be located within 600 feet, or a distance otherwise approved by the City Police Chief, from any existing school, daycare center or youth center as defined by state law. Measurements shall be from property boundary to property boundary. For purposes of this section, "school" means any public or private school providing instruction in kindergarten or grades 1-12, inclusive, but does not include any private school in which education is primarily conducted in private homes.
- **Section 2:** Ordinance 2019-03, in all other material respects, shall remain the same.
- **Section 3:** This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.
- **Section 4:** The City Clerk is authorized and directed to cause this ordinance to be codified after its adoption.
- **Section 5:** The City Clerk is further authorized and directed to cause this ordinance, or a summary of this ordinance, to be published once in a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the City of Lemoore within fifteen (15) days after its adoption. If a summary of this ordinance is published, then the City Clerk also shall cause a summary of the proposed ordinance to be published and a certified copy of the full text of the proposed ordinance to be posted in the Office of the City Clerk at least five (5) days prior to the Council's meeting at which the ordinance is to be adopted and again after the meeting at which the ordinance is adopted. The City Attorney shall approve the summary.

#### **Proposed Motion:**

Conduct a public hearing and accept public comment on the consideration of a Project Development Agreement (PDA) and a Cannabis Regulatory Permit proposed by and between the City of Lemoore and FARM Lemoore, LLC (Developer). Authorize the City Manager or designee to sign PDA and issue Cannabis Regulatory Permit.

#### Subject/Discussion:

On August 18, 2020, Council approved Resolution 2020-29 Rescinding Disposition and Development Agreement and First Amendment (DDA) with KKAL, LP. This PDA proposes to convey the approximately 83.5 acres (APN 024-051-031) ("Site") covered by the DDA to Developer for cannabis cultivation. Staff has been working simultaneously on negotiations with the Developer to enter into a Project Development Agreement.

Ordinance 2019-03 went into effect August 2, 2019. Per the Ordinance, no person or entity can operate a Commercial Cannabis Operation within city limits without obtaining a Regulatory Permit and entering into a Project Development Agreement. The Developer has successfully completed the application process and all required background checks.

On August 18, 2020, Council also adopted an Addendum to a November 6, 2018 Mitigated Negative Declaration. Council found that the proposed use for the Site (agricultural cultivation) is substantially less intense than the industrial uses proposed for the Site under the previous DDA.

#### **Financial Consideration(s):**

NHC Lemoore will be responsible for a fee of 2% of gross receipts from the Project operations or Spot Pricing, whichever is greater within 30 days of the crop sale.

# PROJECT DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT CITY OF LEMOORE

**AND** 

FARM LEMOORE, LLC

#### DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT

This Project Development Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into effective August \_\_\_, 2020 ("Effective Date") between the City of Lemoore, a California charter city ("City") and FARM Lemoore, LLC, a California limited liability company ("Developer"), with respect to the following Recitals, which are a substantive part of this Agreement:

#### **RECITALS**

- A. On December 4, 2019 the Lemoore City Council approved a Disposition and Development Agreement ("DDA") with KKAL, LP ("KKAL"), whereby the City conveyed approximately 83.5 acres at the northeast corner of State Route 41 and Idaho Avenue (APN 024-051-031, and hereinafter the "Property") (Exhibit A) to KKAL for the purpose of developing a manufacturing, distribution, and warehouse center of approximately 1,025,000 square feet of building space with related secondary economic benefit. The Property is planned Light Industrial pursuant to the Lemoore 2030 General Plan, and is zoned consistent with the designated land use.
- B. On March 17, 2020, the City Council approved an amendment to the DDA ("First Amendment"), whereby KKAL agreed to exchange 24 of the 83.5 acres to allow the City to use for storm drainage purposes, and the City agreed to convey approximately 12 acres located on the corner of Idaho Avenue and 19th Avenue (APN 024-051-30) to KKAL.
- C. City staff engaged in discussions with Developer regarding taking over the Site from KKAL, and developing the Site with a less intense commercial cannabis cultivation operation, with related uses ("Project"), in accordance with California's Medicinal and Adult-Use Cannabis Regulation and Safety Act ("MAUCRSA" or the "Act"), as well as City's Ordinance No. 2019-03 ("Ordinance"), as set forth in the City's Municipal Code. In order to accomplish this transaction, KKAL agreed to rescind the existing DDA and First Amendment, subject to KKAL's receipt of an option to purchase nine acres of City property on a separate site. In turn, Developer agreed pay KKAL \$1,700,000.00 as consideration for the purchase of the Site.
- D. An Initial Study pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") had been previously prepared for a 1,000,000 sq. ft. industrial project on the Site, and a Mitigated Negative Declaration ("MND") was adopted by the Lemoore City Council on November 6, 2018. Because the current Project is changed from the project originally identified in the MND, the City was required to determine whether an Addendum or Subsequent MND should be prepared. The City determined that the changes from the original project would not result in any new significant impacts or substantially increase the severity of impacts previously identified in the MND, and there were no previously infeasible alternatives that are now feasible. As proposed Project is substantially less intensive than the industrial project that was evaluated, the City determined that an Addendum to the MND is appropriate.
- E. This Agreement is contingent on Developer obtaining a commercial cannabis regulatory permit ("Regulatory Permit") pursuant to the Ordinance.

- F. Developer represents that its principals are experienced developers and/or operators of commercial cannabis operations or have otherwise contracted with experienced commercial developers, operators, contractors, and other professionals for the purposes of developing the Project on the Property. Developer acknowledges that it be responsible for all improvements to the Property necessary for the Project.
- G. Developer represents its intention to use reasonable efforts to hire City residents to work in its commercial cannabis operations, and City encourages Developer to hire locally.
- **NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to the authority contained in the California's Development Agreement statutes (Government Code section 65864, et seq.), enacted pursuant to Article XI, Section 2 of the California Constitution, and in consideration of the foregoing recitals of fact, all of which are expressly incorporated into this Agreement, the mutual covenants set forth in this Agreement, the City and Developer agree as follows:
- **Levelopment of Property.** Developer proposes to develop and operate the Property for a Commercial Cannabis Operation under MAUCRSA and the Ordinance, which includes a commercial cannabis cultivation operation, with related uses. To this end, Developer shall pay \$1,700,000.00 to KKAL as consideration for the purchase of the Property and agrees to complete the execution of all documents necessary for such purchase prior to developing the Property. Developer will allow the continued use of the Hess basin as a storm drain basin and grant necessary easements and an open ditch from the lift station or alternative water transfer option as agreed upon by the City to ensure water transfer and use of the basin for storm drain purposes. Developer shall pay the following:
  - Developer to pay for all infrastructure and development costs relating to the 83.5 acres.
  - Developer to install 8' chain link fence with barbed wire around complete perimeter with lighting and security cameras.
  - Developer has the option to install wind screens up to 12' inside the perimeter.
  - Developer must provide on-site security personnel for two weeks before crop harvest and during drying, 24 hours per day.
  - Developer will allow the City continued use of the Hess Basin on south end of property.
  - Developer will grant easement For transfer of storm drain lift station and transfer canal and/or line.

City must approve a Regulatory Permit prior to the development of the Property. The exact Commercial Cannabis Operation to be approved for the Property will be determined during the Regulatory Permit process, but shall be consistent with the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

**II.** <u>Lawfulness of Activities</u>. In entering into this Agreement and processing the Regulatory Permit, the City makes no guarantees or promises as to the lawfulness of the proposed commercial cannabis operations under State or federal law, and Developer is obligated to comply with all applicable laws. To the fullest extent permitted by law, City shall not assume any liability

whatsoever with respect to approving the Ordinance, a Regulatory Permit for Developer, or any other commercial cannabis operation approved by City.

- III. <u>Developer Representations</u>. Developer represents and warrants that Developer, and/or principal members of Developer, is/are an experienced developer and operator of commercial properties with experience in cannabis operations, or has otherwise contracted with experienced commercial developers, architects, and/or other professionals for the purpose of developing the Property. The qualifications and identity of Developer and Developer's contractors are of particular concern to City, and because of such qualifications and identity, the City has entered into this Agreement with Developer. City has considered and relied upon Developer's representations and warranties in entering into this Agreement.
- **IV.** <u>Fees</u>. Developer shall pay to City the following fees: Developer agrees to pay to the City 2% of gross receipts or Spot Pricing whichever is higher within 30 days of crop sale.

The requirements of this Section shall be a recorded covenant running with the land and binding on all owners, tenants, and Regulatory Permit holders for the Property. The covenants shall expire on the expiration or earlier termination of this Agreement.

- **V.** <u>Local Contractors</u>. To the extent practical, Developer will use reasonable efforts to hire construction/remodel contractors for the Property that are based within the City of Lemoore or whose work force is made up of a significant number (e.g. 30%) of residents of the City of Lemoore. Nothing in this section V. shall be construed to require Developer to accept a bid from a contractor that is more than five percent (5%) higher than the lowest bid received for the same or similar work.
- VI. Compliance with Laws. Developer shall operate the commercial cannabis operation in conformity MAUCRSA and any implementing regulations, as they may be amended from time to time. Developer shall comply with all other applicable laws, state labor standards, City zoning and development standards, building, plumbing, mechanical and electrical codes, all other provisions of the Lemoore Municipal Code, and all applicable disabled and handicapped access requirements, including without limitation the Americans With Disabilities Act, 42 U.S.C. Section 12101, et seq., California Government Code Section 4450, et seq., California Government Code Section 11135, et seq., and the Unruh Civil Rights Act, Civil Code Section 51, et seq. with respect to the existing and any proposed improvements on the Property.

### VII. Developer's Indemnity.

a. <u>Commercial Cannabis Operations</u>. Developer shall defend, indemnify, assume all responsibility for, and hold City and its officers, agents, employees, and volunteers, harmless from all claims, demands, damages, defense costs or liability of any kind or nature arising from or related to any State or federal law enforcement action against Developer, Developer's tenants, subtenants, licensees, contractors and employees ("**Developer Parties**") in connection with the commercial cannabis operation conducted on the Property after the issuance of the Regulatory Permit ("**Cannabis Claims**"). Developer's defense and indemnity obligations under this Agreement shall apply, regardless of intent or fault, to any allegation or claim of liability brought

against the City related to the subject Project, including land use and environmental law actions or meeting notice law actions following Project approval, modification, or denial. Applicant's duty shall arise at the first claim, petition, or allegation of liability against City. Developer's indemnity shall not extend to any loss of revenue suffered or incurred by City in connection with any termination, cessation, restriction, seizure, or other limitation of any commercial cannabis operation on the Property.

b. <u>Construction and Other Operations</u>. In addition to the indemnity obligations of subsection (a), Developer shall defend, indemnify, assume all responsibility for, and hold City and its officers, agents, employees, and volunteers, harmless from all claims, demands, damages, defense costs or liability of any kind or nature relating to the subject matter of this Agreement or the implementation thereof, including all construction and operation activities on the Property, and for any damages to property or injuries to persons, including accidental death (including attorneys' fees and costs), which may be caused by any acts or omissions of Developer Parties in the performance under this Agreement, whether such damage shall accrue or be discovered before or after termination of this Agreement ("**Other Claims**"). Developer's liability under this Subsection (b) is limited to the extent the property damage or bodily injury is caused by the sole negligence or willful misconduct of City or its agents or employees.

### VIII. Restrictions on Transfer.

- a. <u>City Approval Prior to Closing</u>. Prior to acquisition of the Property, Developer shall not transfer this Agreement or any of Developer's rights hereunder, directly or indirectly, voluntarily or by operation of law, without the prior written approval of City, and if so purported to be transferred, the same shall be null and void. In considering whether it will grant approval to any assignment by Developer of its rights hereunder, City shall consider factors such as (a) the financial strength and capability of the proposed assignee to perform Developer's obligations hereunder; and (b) the proposed assignee's experience and expertise in the planning, financing, development, ownership, and operation of similar projects.
- b. <u>Assignee Obligations</u>. In the absence of specific written agreement by City, no assignment or transfer by Developer of all or any portion of its rights shall be deemed to relieve it or any successor party from any obligations under this Agreement. In addition, no attempted assignment of any of Developer's obligations hereunder shall be effective unless and until the successor party executes and delivers to City an assumption agreement in a form reasonably approved by the City assuming such obligations.
- IX. Defaults and Remedies. Failure by either party to perform any action or covenant required by this Agreement within the time periods provided herein, following notice and failure to cure as described hereafter, constitutes a "**Default**" under this Agreement. A party claiming a Default shall give written Notice of Default ("**Notice**") to the other party specifying the Default complained of. Except as otherwise expressly provided in this Agreement, the claimant shall not institute any proceeding against any other party, and the other party shall not be in Default if such party within fifteen (15) days from receipt of such Notice immediately, with due diligence, commences to cure, correct or remedy such failure or delay and shall diligently complete such cure, correction or remedy.

In addition to any other rights or remedies and subject to the restrictions otherwise set forth in this Agreement, either party may institute an action at law or equity to seek specific performance of the terms of this Agreement, or to cure, correct or remedy any Default, to recover damages for any Default, or to obtain any other remedy consistent with the purpose of this Agreement. Such legal actions must be instituted in the Superior Court of the County of Kings, California, or in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of California – Fresno Division, if allowable.

### X. General Provisions.

a. <u>Notices, Demands, and Communications Between the Parties</u>. Any approval, disapproval, demand, document or other notice ("Notice") which either party may desire to give to the other party under this Agreement must be in writing and may be given by any commercially acceptable means to the party to whom the Notice is directed at the address of the party as set forth below, or at any other address as that party may later designate by Notice.

Any written notice, demand or communication shall be deemed received: immediately if delivered by hand; 24 hours after delivery to a receipted, overnight delivery service such as Federal Express; 24 hours after delivery by e-mail with an acknowledgement of receipt by the intended recipient; and on the fourth (4th) day from the date it is postmarked if delivered by registered or certified mail.

- b. <u>Successors and Assigns</u>. All of the terms, covenants, and conditions of this Agreement shall be binding upon Developer and City, and their respective successors and assigns. Whenever the term "Developer" is used in this Agreement, such term shall include any other successors and assigns as herein provided. This Agreement shall run with the land and be binding upon Developer's successors and assigns in and to the Property.
- c. <u>Relationship Between City and Developer</u>. It is hereby acknowledged that the relationship between City and Developer is not that of a partnership or joint venture and that City and Developer shall not be deemed or construed for any purpose to be the agent of the other. Except as expressly provided herein or in the Attachments hereto, City shall not have any rights, powers, duties or obligations with respect to the Project.
- d. <u>No Third-Party Beneficiaries</u>. There shall be no third-party beneficiaries of this Agreement.
- e. <u>City Approvals and Actions</u>. City shall maintain authority over this Agreement, and the authority to implement this Agreement through the City Manager (or his/her duly authorized representative). The City Manager shall have the authority to make approvals, issue interpretations, waive provisions, and/or enter into certain amendments of this Agreement on behalf of City so long as such actions do not materially or substantially change the uses or development contemplated under this Agreement, and such approvals, interpretations, waivers and/or amendments may include extensions of time to perform if applicable. All other material and/or substantive interpretations, waivers, or amendments shall require the consideration, action and written consent of the City Council.
- f. <u>Counterparts</u>. This Agreement may be signed in multiple counterparts which, when signed by all parties, shall constitute a binding agreement. This Agreement shall be executed in two (2) originals, each of which is deemed to be an original.
- g. <u>Integration</u>. This Agreement contains the entire understanding between the parties relating to the transaction contemplated by this Agreement, notwithstanding any previous negotiations or agreements between the parties or their predecessors in interest with respect to all or any part of the subject matter hereof. All prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, representations and statements, oral or written, are merged in this Agreement and shall be of no further force or effect. Each party is entering this Agreement based solely upon the representations set forth herein and upon each party's own independent investigation of any and all facts such party deems material. This Agreement includes all Attachments and Exhibits attached hereto, which are incorporated herein.

- h. <u>Interpretation and Applicable Law</u>. This Agreement has been prepared with input from both parties, and shall be interpreted as though prepared jointly by both parties. The laws of the State of California shall govern the interpretation and enforcement of this Agreement.
- i. <u>No Waiver</u>. Any failures or delays by either party in asserting any of its rights and remedies as to any Default shall not operate as a waiver of any Default or of any such rights or remedies, or deprive either such party of its right to institute and maintain any actions or proceedings which it may deem necessary to protect, assert or enforce any such rights or remedies. Nor shall a waiver by either party of a breach of any of the covenants, conditions or promises under this Agreement to be performed by the other party be construed as a waiver of any succeeding breach of the same or other covenants, agreements, restrictions or conditions of this Agreement.
- j. <u>Modifications</u>. For any alteration, change or modification of or to this Agreement to become effective, it shall be made in writing and in each instance signed on behalf of each party.
- k. <u>Legal Advice</u>. Each party represents and warrants to the other the following: They have carefully read this Agreement, and in signing this Agreement, they do so with full knowledge of any right which they may have; they have received independent legal advice from their respective legal counsel as to the matters set forth in this Agreement, or have knowingly chosen not to consult legal counsel as to the matters set forth in this Agreement; and, they have freely signed this Agreement without any reliance upon any agreement, promise, statement or representation by or on behalf of the other party, or their respective agents, employees, or attorneys, except as specifically set forth in this Agreement, and without duress or coercion, whether economic or otherwise.
- l. <u>Cooperation</u>. Each party agrees to cooperate with the other in this transaction and, in that regard, to sign any and all documents which may be reasonably necessary, helpful, or appropriate to carry out the purposes and intent of this Agreement including, but not limited to, releases or additional agreements.
- m. <u>Non-Liability of Officials and Employees of the City</u>. No official, employee or agent of the City shall be personally liable to the Developer, or any successor in interest, in the event of any Default or breach by the City or for any amount which may become due to the Developer or its successors, or on any obligations under the terms of this Agreement.
- n. <u>Attorneys' Fees</u>. In any action between the parties to interpret, enforce, reform, modify, rescind, or otherwise in connection with any of the terms or provisions of this Agreement, the prevailing party in the action shall be entitled, in addition to damages, injunctive relief, or any other relief to which it might be entitled, reasonable costs and expenses including, without limitation, litigation costs and reasonable attorneys' fees.
- o. <u>Term.</u> The term of this Agreement ("Term") shall be for a period of Twenty Five (25) years commencing on the Effective Date. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein, the Term shall be automatically be extended one (1) additional period of fifteen (15) years after the initial expiration date unless either party gives written notice of intent to terminate to the other

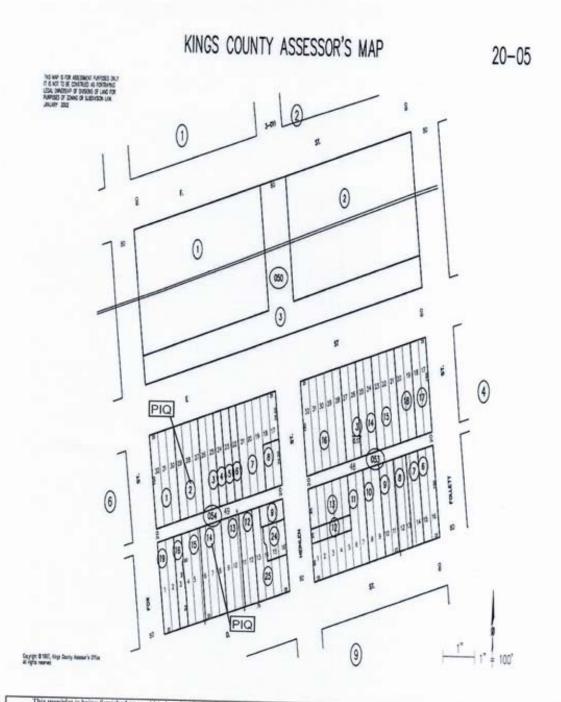

The League's 2020 Annual Conference & Expo is scheduled for October 7-9. An important part of the Annual Conference is the Annual Business Meeting (during General Assembly) on Friday, October 9. At this meeting, the League membership considers and takes action on resolutions that establish League policy.

In order to vote at the Annual Business Meeting, your city council must designate a voting delegate. Your city may also appoint up to two alternate voting delegates, one of whom may vote in the event that the designated voting delegate is unable to serve in that capacity.

Please complete the attached Voting Delegate form and return it to the League's office no later than Wednesday, September 30. This will allow us time to establish voting delegate/alternate records prior to the conference.

Please note the following procedures are intended to ensure the integrity of the voting process at the Annual Business Meeting. <u>These procedures assume that the conference will be held inperson at the Long Beach Convention Center as planned. Should COVID-19 conditions and restrictions prohibit the League from holding an in-person conference, new procedures will be provided.</u>

- Action by Council Required. Consistent with League bylaws, a city's voting delegate and up to two alternates must be designated by the city council. When completing the attached Voting Delegate form, please attach either a copy of the council resolution that reflects the council action taken, or have your city clerk or mayor sign the form affirming that the names provided are those selected by the city council. Please note that designating the voting delegate and alternates must be done by city council action and cannot be accomplished by individual action of the mayor or city manager alone.
- Conference Registration Required. The voting delegate and alternates must be registered to attend the conference. They need not register for the entire conference; they may register for Friday only. Conference registration will open by the end of July at <a href="https://www.cacities.org">www.cacities.org</a>. In order to cast a vote, at least one voter must be present at the Business Meeting and in possession of the voting delegate card. Voting delegates and alternates need to pick up their conference badges before signing in and picking up the voting delegate card at the Voting Delegate Desk. This will enable them to receive the

special sticker on their name badges that will admit them into the voting area during the Business Meeting.

- Transferring Voting Card to Non-Designated Individuals Not Allowed. The voting delegate card may be transferred freely between the voting delegate and alternates, but *only* between the voting delegate and alternates. If the voting delegate and alternates find themselves unable to attend the Business Meeting, they may *not* transfer the voting card to another city official.
- **Seating Protocol during General Assembly.** At the Business Meeting, individuals with the voting card will sit in a separate area. Admission to this area will be limited to those individuals with a special sticker on their name badge identifying them as a voting delegate or alternate. If the voting delegate and alternates wish to sit together, they must sign in at the Voting Delegate Desk and obtain the special sticker on their badges.

The Voting Delegate Desk, located in the conference registration area of the Long Beach Convention Center, will be open at the following times: Wednesday, October 7, 8:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.; Thursday, October 8, 7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.; and Friday, October 9, 7:30 a.m.–11:30 a.m.. The Voting Delegate Desk will also be open at the Business Meeting on Friday, but will be closed during roll calls and voting.

### **Annual Conference Voting Procedures**

- 1. **One City One Vote.** Each member city has a right to cast one vote on matters pertaining to League policy.
- 2. **Designating a City Voting Representative.** Prior to the Annual Conference, each city council may designate a voting delegate and up to two alternates; these individuals are identified on the Voting Delegate Form provided to the League Credentials Committee.
- 3. **Registering with the Credentials Committee.** The voting delegate, or alternates, may pick up the city's voting card at the Voting Delegate Desk in the conference registration area. Voting delegates and alternates must sign in at the Voting Delegate Desk. Here they will receive a special sticker on their name badge and thus be admitted to the voting area at the Business Meeting.
- 4. **Signing Initiated Resolution Petitions**. Only those individuals who are voting delegates (or alternates), and who have picked up their city's voting card by providing a signature to the Credentials Committee at the Voting Delegate Desk, may sign petitions to initiate a resolution.
- 5. **Voting.** To cast the city's vote, a city official must have in his or her possession the city's voting card and be registered with the Credentials Committee. The voting card may be transferred freely between the voting delegate and alternates, but may not be transferred to another city official who is neither a voting delegate or alternate.
- 6. **Voting Area at Business Meeting.** At the Business Meeting, individuals with a voting card will sit in a designated area. Admission will be limited to those individuals with a special sticker on their name badge identifying them as a voting delegate or alternate.
- 7. **Resolving Disputes**. In case of dispute, the Credentials Committee will determine the validity of signatures on petitioned resolutions and the right of a city official to vote at the Business Meeting.
