On Sunday November 1st, 2020 at 10:18 AM, Lemoore Police Officers were dispatched to the 1300 block of San Simeon Dr. for a report of shots fired into a residence. Patrol officers conducted an initial investigation and found that multiple rounds had been fired into an occupied residence. Furthermore, Officers found the shots were fired from a vehicle on November 1st at around 1:00 AM.

The investigation was turned over to Lemoore PD Detectives. The shooter was identified by Detectives as Joel Gutierrez (26). Gutierrez was arrested with the assistance of the Kings County Major Crimes Task Force on Tuesday, November 3rd, 2020 at about 2:30 PM.

Detectives were also able to identify Bryan Salazar (29) as a suspect involved in this shooting. Bryan Salazar was arrested on Tuesday November 3rd, 2020. Detectives served a search warrant at his residence and located a loaded handgun that had been reported stolen out of Yolo County.
