On Sunday, December 13, 2020, at about 11:34 PM, Lemoore Police Officers responded to Roza's Jewelry store, located in the 300 block of West D St, for a report of a subject attempting to break inside. Upon arrival, officers located a broken window and door to the business, and were able to determine that several items of jewelry had been stolen, however, the suspect was not located. At about 12:46 AM, officers responded back to the same business because the suspect had returned. As Officers arrived, the suspect entered an apartment building in the 300 block of Heinlen St. Through investigation, Officers were able to identify the suspect as 23 year old Nicholas Cabral of Hanford. Cabral was arrested without incident. A search warrant was issued for the apartment Cabral was in, and the stolen jewelry, along with other evidence, was recovered.

On Monday, December 14, 2020, Lemoore Police Officers responded to a burglary report that occurred sometime over the weekend at the Lemoore Transmissions also located in the 300 block of Heinlen St. Through investigation, Officers were able to determine Cabral was also involved in that case.

Cabral was arrested and booked into the Kings County Jail for violations of burglary and vandalism of both businesses. Cabral's bail was set at \$60,000.
