## PRESS RELEASE

On July 21<sup>st</sup>, 2021 at around 11:30 PM, Lemoore Police Officers were dispatched to an apartment complex located in the 200 block of N Lemoore Ave. to investigate the report of a male making criminal threats and shooting a gun into the air. Soon after officers arrived on scene, the male opened the overhead garage door and was heard chambering a round into a semi-automatic pistol. LPD Officers contacted the male and he complied with officer's commands. The male was detained without further incident and a loaded pistol was located nearby.

The male was identified as 34 year old, Caleb Alexander Corkill, of Lemoore. Through investigation, officers learned Corkill threw an explosive device at a neighbor's vehicle. Corkill is a convicted Felon and is prohibited from possessing firearms.

Corkill was arrested and booked into Kings County Jail for the charges of criminal threats, possession of a destructive device, explode or ignite a destructive device, felon in possession of a firearm and carrying a concealed weapon. Corkill's bail was set at \$95,000 dollars.
