## PRESS RELEASE

Between January 13th and January 17th, 2022 the Lemoore Police Department responded to six separate residential burglaries located within the Cinnamon Villa apartment complex. During each of these burglaries the suspect forced entry into the residence either by kicking in the front door or entering through an unlocked window. The burglaries were sporadic in time ranging from early morning hours to mid-day. During 3 of these burglaries the victims were home and asleep while the suspect gained entry into their apartment. During one burglary, the suspect had stolen keys to a vehicle from within the residence then stole the vehicle parked outside.

On January 15th, an LPD officer saw a male suspect climbing out the front window of an apartment. Believing the suspect had possibly just burglarized the residence the officer attempted to make contact with the suspect but the suspect fled on foot and avoided capture.

During the course of the investigation officers were able to identify the suspect as Arthur Harris, 21 years old of Lemoore. On February 1st, working in conjunction with the Kings County Major Crimes Task Force, Arthur Harris was located while still in possession of the previously stolen vehicle. He was taken into custody without incident. Miracle Mitchell, 20 years old of Lemoore, was with Arthur Harris and also arrested.

Arthur Harris was booked into Kings County Jail for the charges of burglary, unlawful use of an access card, auto theft, possession of a stolen vehicle and financial abuse of an elder. Harris's bail was set at \$225,000. Miracle Mitchell was booked into Kings County Jail for possession of a stolen vehicle and her bail was set at \$10,000.
