PRESS RELEASE

On July 27th, 2022, at around 7:13 PM, Lemoore Police Officers were dispatched to the 1200 block of Sierra Cir. to investigate a report of a male gun shot victim. Officers arrived on scene and located a 43-year-old male from Lemoore suffering from a gunshot wound to his head. He was transported to a local area hospital and is listed in stable condition.

The suspect was identified as 40-year-old, Daniel Garcia, of Armona. A short time later Garcia was located by California Highway Patrol and led them on a high-speed pursuit. With the assistance of the Kings County Sheriff's Office, and other allied agencies Garcia was apprehended in the City of Hanford. A short-barreled shotgun, shotgun ammunition, and pistol were recovered as a result of the pursuit.

Garcia is a convicted felon prohibited from possessing firearms. Garcia was arrested and booked into Kings County Jail for the charges of Attempted murder, Felon in possession of a firearm, Felon in possession of ammunition, Possession of a short-barreled shotgun, Removing the serial number from a firearm and evading a peace officer. Garcia's bail was set at \$ 595,000.
