## NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY Draft Program Environmental Impact Report for the Draft 2022 Regional Transportation Plan/Sustainable Communities Strategy

Notice is hereby given that the Kings County Association of Governments (KCAG) has released the Draft Program Environmental Impact Report (DPEIR) document for a 45-day public review/comment period.

**Proposed Project**: 2022 Regional Transportation Plan and Sustainable Communities Strategy (2022 RTP/SCS).

**Project Description:** The proposed 2022 RTP/SCS is the region's long range transportation plan/land use strategy through 2046 for the Kings County region. The proposed 2022 RTP/SCS is an update to the current 2018 RTP/SCS that was adopted on August 22, 2018. The proposed 2022 RTP/SCS reflects changes in legislative requirements, local land use policies, and resource constraints that have occurred since adoption of the current 2018 RTP/SCS. The 2022 update to the 2018 RTP/SCS is focused on continued implementation of the 2018 RTP/SCS, with updates to ensure consistency with federal, State, and local planning requirements. The proposed 2022 RTP/SCS is the long-term coordinated transportation/land use strategy and provides a framework for transportation investment out to the year 2046.

**Project Location:** The proposed 2022 RTP/SCS covers the entire area of Kings County and includes the cities of Avenal, Corcoran, Hanford, and Lemoore. Capital improvement transportation projects, identified in the proposed 2022 RTP/SCS, are located on State Routes, County roads, and locally owned streets, as well as on transit district property, airport property, and public utility lands.

**Environmental Effects:** The DPEIR provides a programmatic analysis of environmental impacts related to the implementation of the proposed 2022 RTP/SCS. It discloses significant effects for the following resource categories: aesthetics, agriculture, air quality, biological resources, cultural resources, geology and soils, greenhouse gas emissions and climate change, hazards and hazardous materials, hydrology and water quality, noise, transportation, tribal cultural resources, and wildfire.
