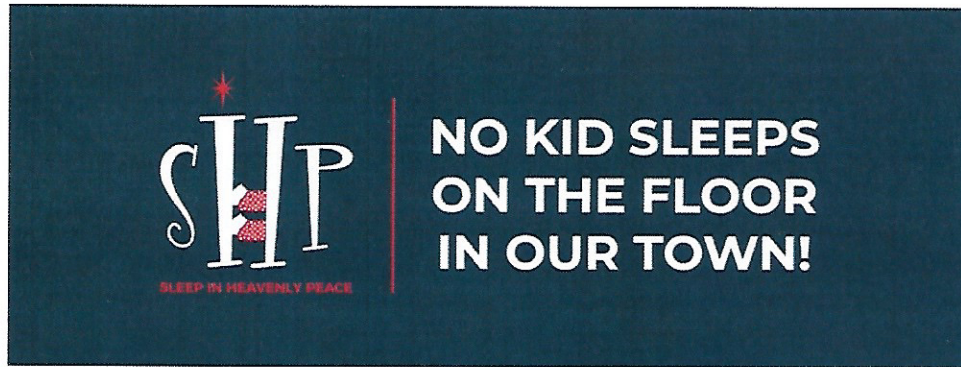

Council Members,

I'd like to submit comment (image below) on the approval of the new City Street Sweeper being purchased to the price of more than \$400,000.00 dollars.

If the City of Lemoore is going to invest more than what the average house is worth in the City of Lemoore, they should also enact a "no street parking" during specific weekdays so that the street sweeper can perform its duties that it was purchased for.

This "no street parking" for specific days of the week in identified neighborhoods (similar to the trash collection schedule), would be enforced by local law enforcement issuing citations for vehicles, RV's and other items left on the curb. Any funds raised by the citations could assist in a surplus that would help pay for the new street sweeper.
