ADDENDUM NO. 2

ON-CALL WELL MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR SERVICES CONTRACT

This **ADDENDUM NO. 2** is hereby issued to respond to proposer questions regarding the Contract Booklet and Bid Proposal for the above-referenced project. All proposers shall incorporate this Addendum into their proposal submissions.

1. PURPOSE OF ADDENDUM

The purpose of this Addendum is to:

- Provide clarification in response to proposer questions;
- Maintain consistency with the Contract Booklet and Bid Proposal requirements;
- Promote clear understanding of licensing and pricing expectations; and
- Preserve fair and equal competition among all proposers.

2. RESPONSES TO PROPOSER QUESTIONS

Question 1 – Q&A Deadline

Is there a Q&A deadline?

Response:

Yes. The deadline for submitting questions related to this solicitation is **May 4th at 5:30 PM**. All substantive responses to proposer questions will be issued through formal written addenda. Proposers shall rely only on the Contract Documents and issued addenda when preparing their proposals.

Question 2 – Contractor Licensing and Qualifications

(Contract Booklet and Specifications, Page 14, Subsection 3.2)

Are bidders required to hold all license classifications listed in Subsection 3.2? If a bidder holds a C-61/D-21 license but does not hold a C-57 license and plans to partner with a subcontractor holding a C-57 license, will this meet the licensing requirement?

Response:

Bidders must comply with all applicable contractor licensing requirements under California law at the time of performance. Licensing requirements may be satisfied through the use of properly licensed subcontractors, provided that:

- The prime contractor holds a valid license appropriate to its scope of work; and
- All subcontracted work is performed by subcontractors holding the required license classifications for that portion of the work.

Compliance with California Contractors State License Board (CSLB) requirements is the responsibility of the proposer.



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Question 3 – Bid Proposal Pricing

Are bidders required to include taxes and miscellaneous fees in the unit prices?

Response:

Yes. Proposers shall include all applicable taxes, fees, overhead, and incidental costs in their proposed unit prices, unless expressly stated otherwise in the Contract Documents. No additional charges beyond the proposed unit prices shall be paid.

3. NO CHANGE TO SCOPE, DUE DATE, OR EVALUATION METHOD

Except as expressly stated in this Addendum:

- The scope of work remains unchanged;
- The proposal due date remains unchanged; and
- The evaluation criteria and award method remain unchanged.

All other terms and conditions of the Contract Documents remain in full force and effect.
