Six signature *amenities*, one walkable destination.


From sun-soaked dining patios to string-lit evenings, every element of the new E Street has been crafted to encourage gathering, commerce, and play.

Food Truck Vendor Area


A dedicated zone for the region's best mobile kitchens, rotating throughout the week.

Lemoore Arbor Plaza


The beloved entertainment plaza is woven into the corridor as its eastern anchor.

A canopy of warm bulbs transforms the corridor into a glowing nightscape.

04 – THE SITE PLAN

A place *where* community starts.

Spanning the block between Heinlen Street and Follett Street, the new E Street unfolds as a layered corridor – entered through illuminated welcome monuments, anchored by the Lemoore Arbor Plaza, and connected to Lemoore Stadium Cinemas and existing neighborhood favorites.

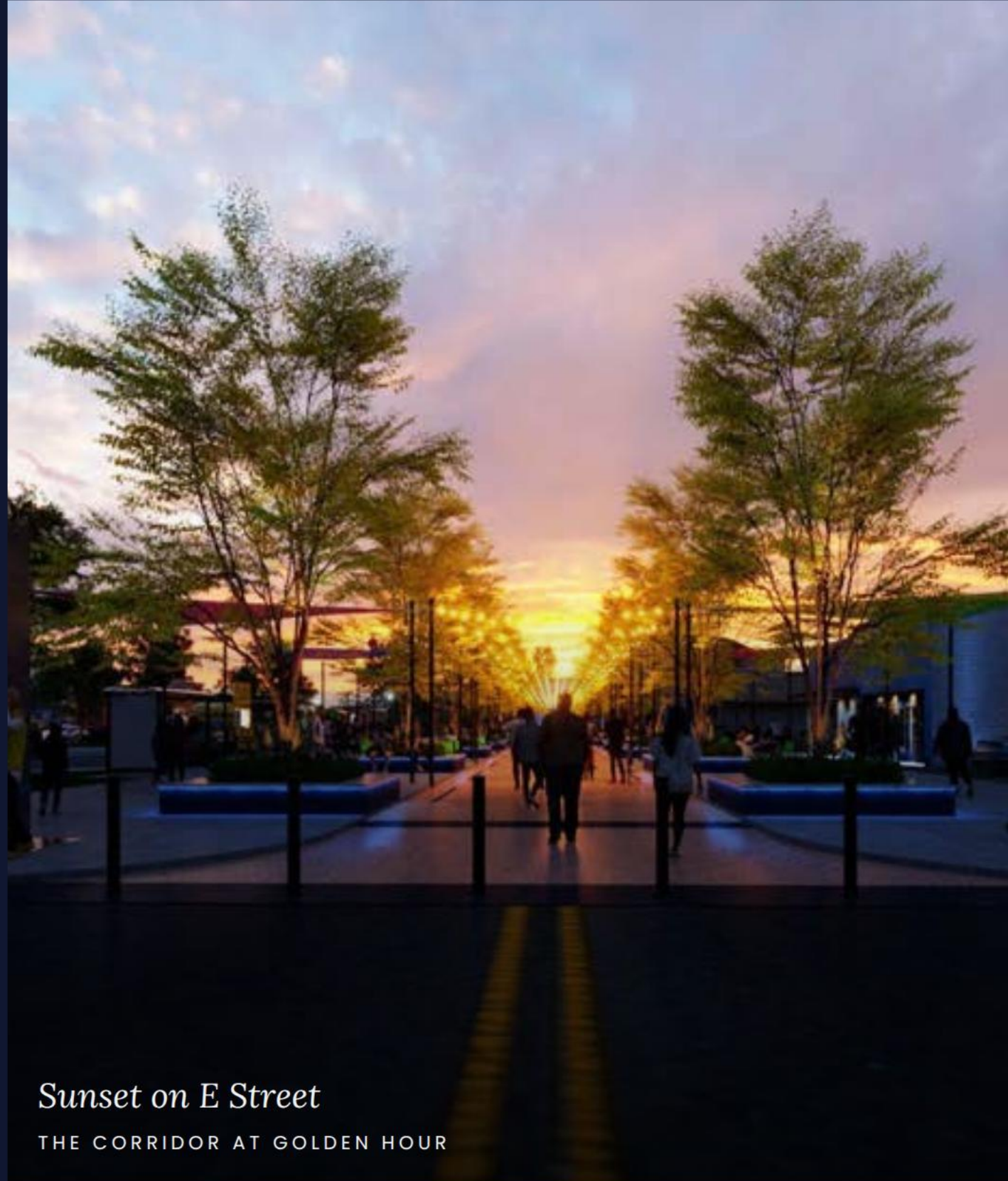
