**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Lemoore Planning Commission will conduct a Public Hearing at its Regular Meeting Monday, June 8, 2026, at 5:30 p.m. in the Lemoore Council Chamber located at 429 C Street to consider and accept public comment for the 2024-2032 6<sup>th</sup> Cycle Housing Element Update.

The City of Lemoore has determined that the adoption of the 2024-2032 6<sup>th</sup> Cycle Housing Element Update is exempt from further environmental review under the common sense exemption of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3). The Housing Element is a comprehensive, high-level policy document and a long-range planning tool required by State law to guide future housing choices and accommodate the jurisdiction's Regional Housing Needs Allocation (RHNA).

If you challenge the proposed action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City at, or prior to, the Public Hearing.
