PROPOSED ADDENDUM NO. 2

Clarification of Section 4.8 – Licensing and Performance Responsibility Matrix

Question 1

May a Proposer identify both self-performed and subcontracted work within the same Service Category?

Response

No. For purposes of Section 4.8, Proposers shall identify the anticipated primary method of performance for each Service Category by selecting either **"Self-Perform"** or **"Subcontract."** The selected designation shall represent the Proposer's anticipated primary performing entity for that Service Category.

Nothing in the Licensing and Performance Responsibility Matrix prohibits a Proposer from utilizing specialty subcontractors, vendors, suppliers, equipment providers, repair facilities, manufacturers, or other qualified firms in support of contract performance, provided that:

1. The Proposer remains fully responsible for all Services performed under the Contract;
2. Any work requiring a California contractor license is performed by an entity holding the appropriate license classification;
3. Applicable subcontractors are disclosed and utilized in accordance with applicable California law; and
4. All applicable licensing, permitting, certification, and regulatory requirements are satisfied.

The purpose of the Licensing and Performance Responsibility Matrix is to identify the anticipated primary performing entity and associated licensing responsibility for each Service Category.

Question 2

For the Motor Repair Service Category, may a Proposer identify an off-site motor repair facility rather than a licensed subcontractor?

Response

Yes. For purposes of Section 4.8, the Proposer shall identify the entity proposed to perform motor repair services, including any off-site repair facility, specialty service provider, equipment manufacturer, subcontractor, or other performing entity.

The Proposer shall remain solely responsible for:

- Identifying the performing entity;
- Ensuring the performing entity possesses all licenses, certifications, registrations, and qualifications required by applicable law;
- Compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local requirements; and
- Performance of the resulting contract.

Nothing in this clarification shall be construed as a determination by the City regarding whether any particular scope of work requires a California contractor license, nor shall it relieve the Proposer of responsibility for complying with applicable licensing requirements. Any work requiring a California contractor license shall be performed by an appropriately licensed entity, consistent with Section 4.9 of the Solicitation and the California Contractors State License Law.

This clarification is issued solely to clarify the completion and interpretation of Section 4.8, Licensing and Performance Responsibility Matrix. Except as expressly stated herein, all terms, conditions, requirements, evaluation criteria, and contract provisions of the Solicitation remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
